### AADD's Work this Year

- Legislative advocacy with Key Coalition
  - \$15 million for rate increase July 1
  - InterRAI Funding
  - \$5 million for Rate Reform
  - Host Home bill passage
- Deepened partnership with ABHA
- Alaska Alliance of Direct Support Professionals
  - Attended National Conference
  - Hosted statewide DSP summit
- Additional DSP Workforce Development
  - DSP certification pilot support
  - MapHabit pilot project

#### AADD's Work this Year

- Addressed System barriers
  - Multiple meetings with Department of Health regarding current rate issues
  - Employment Services Conditions of Participation Advocacy
  - Increased DPA awareness regarding Redetermination issues with long-term care recipients
- AADD Organizational Development
  - ED is now full-time
  - Regional Outreach (Kenai, Fairbanks, Mat-Su and Nome)
